for — Thou art our God, and we are — Thy peo - ple; — we are all —

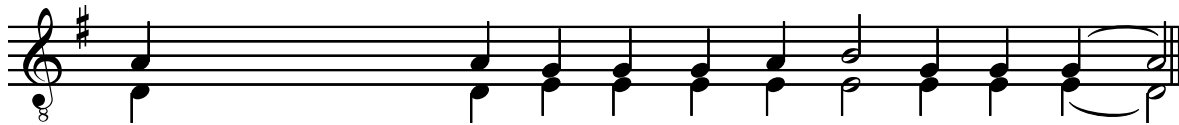

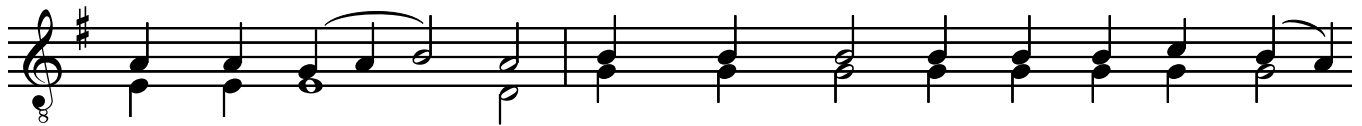
